SAMI BRACELET: REINDEER LEATHER AND PEWTER

The Sami People (also known as Laplanders) are the indigenous people of northern Sweden, Norway, Finland, and the Kola Peninsula of Russia, having a long history and tradition of reindeer breeding. Wanting to use all parts of the reindeer, these people make beautiful jewelry out of reindeer leather. In this class students will start by braiding pewter thread (nickel-free alloy with 4% silver) and sewing it to the reindeer leather. The back of the bracelet is stitched closed using sinew thread and a button clasp made from shed reindeer antler tips. All tools are provided, but students who need magnification or extra lighting for this close hand work should bring their own,


