We will soon be opening the gallery every day for the season — looking at the records, some of you have pieces in the gallery that have been there for several years. We want to “freshen” up the cases - I would love it if YOU would, personally, come and make the choices of what to remove. If not, then I will make the decisions based on when pieces came into the gallery.

Also, our usual limit for each jewelry artist is 25 pieces - some have many more than that. I try to make room for more, based on space in the cases and on the earring trees, if possible.

Please make sure your earring cards have a hanging lip on them, and it's helpful if the cards aren't HUGE! We will use the displays we currently have on top of the cases, so please don't bring in more to sit on top.

We want shoppers to be able to see inside the cases. If I remove some of your pieces, they will be kept in the drawers of the cases to refill. If you remove pieces from the gallery, they need to be removed from the inventory. Need more information on that, contact me, please.

If you have jewelry that tarnishes, it would be good for you to check on yours and clean them. I do not have time to polish everyone's jewelry! Sterling tarnishes fast when it is open to the air so take note of your pieces, please.
